# Line Flowers

- Are used as primary flowers to establish the skeleton outline height or width of an arrangement

# Garden Gladiolus

- **Botanical name:** *Gladiolus x hortulanus* cv.
- **Origin:** Africa
  - **Color:** white, pink, salmon, yellow, orange, red, green and violet



# Snapdragon



- **Botanical name:** *Antirrhinum majus* cv.
- **Origin:** Mediterranean region and Iberian Peninsula
- **Color:** commonly yellow, pink and white; occasionally dark pink, red, bronze or lavender

# Flowering Stock

- **Botanical name:** *Matthiola incana* cv.
- **Origin:** North America
- **Color:** white, red, lavender and yellow





# Tuberose

- **Botanical name:** *Polianthes tuberosa*
- **Origin:** Mexico
- **Color:** white



# Liatriis

- **Botanical name:** *Liatriis spicata*
- **Origin:** North America, Mexico and the Bahamas
- **Color:** shades of purple





# Hyacinth



- **Botanical name:**  
*Hyacinthus orientalis cv.*
- **Origin:** southwestern Asia, central and southern Turkey, northwestern Syria, Lebanon and northern Israel
- **Color:** purple, orange, pink, white and red
